Applications are now being accepted for MSP's Grant Program!

Established in 2010, the Grant Program supports members' activities that advance MSP's mission, such as increased member involvement, political actions, improved working conditions, internal organizing, coalition building, and finding novel ways to address a wide variety of workplace issues. In the past, grant funding has been used to support events, campaigns, and related research projects. Your 3–5-page application must be received in the MSP office by May 1st, 2024 and, if awarded, your project completed within a year. A six-month status report will be due by December 1st, 2024. Grants are reviewed by a committee of MSP members appointed by MSP officers. Applicants will be notified of decisions by 5/31/24. Successful grant recipients are expected to serve on the MSP grant committee at least once.

Complete applications will include:

- Your name, title, and department
- A description of the activity the grant will support
- An explanation of how the activity specifically advances MSP goals
- An itemized budget clearly showing how requested funds will be used
- Plans for publication and/or dissemination of the results (e.g. a report given at MSP membership meeting, article in the MSP newsletter, etc.)

All active, dues-paying members are welcome to apply!

- May 1, 2024: Applications due to MSP
- May 31, 2024: Applicants notified if project funded
- December 1, 2024: Mid-point status report for funded projects due to MSP
- May 1, 2025: Deadline of notice to MSP that projects have been completed
